All taxable property in Oklahoma is required to be rendered to the county assessor between January 1 and March 15 of each year by the owner or person in control of such property. This includes all agricultural machinery, equipment, unmanufactured farm products and livestock unless specifically exempt by law. Property rendered after March 15 but before April 15 shall have a mandatory ten percent penalty applied. Property rendered after April 15 shall have a mandatory twenty percent penalty applied.

NOTICE OF VETERAN'S EXEMPTION

Enlisted and commissioned personnel, whether on active duty or honorably discharged, who served in the armed forces of the United States during wartime or certain periods of national emergency, other than for training purposes, may be eligible for an exemption of household personal property of \$200.00 of the assessed value. Surviving spouses of such veterans may also qualify. **To make application for this exemption, please complete OTC Form 930, available from your county assessor or the OTC website: www.oktax.state.ok.us, and return it to the county assessor on or before March 15.**

PART II HOUSEHOLD PERSONAL PROPERTY

68 O.S. Sec. 2817 A. All taxable personal property, except intangible personal property, personal property exempt from ad valorem taxation, or household personal property, shall be listed and assessed each year at its fair cash value, estimated at the price it would bring at a fair voluntary sale, as of January 1.

The fair cash value of household personal property shall be valued at ten percent (10%) of the appraised value of the improvement to the residential real property within which such personal is located as of January 1 each year.

The assessment of household personal property as provided by this section may be altered by the taxpayer listing such property at its actual fair cash value.
