



## DEFINITIONS

“New Compact” - means retail locations located on trust land owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco products after January 1, 2003.

“Exception Rate” - means certain retail locations on trust lands in other specific locations, owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco products after January 1, 2003.

“State/Tribal” - means certain tribal locations on trust land owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations, which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco products after July 1, 2008.

“State/Tribal Border” - means certain tribal locations or trust land owned or licensed by Federally Recognized Indian Tribes or Nations which signed compacts with the State of Oklahoma regarding cigarette and tobacco that are within 20 miles of either the Kansas or Missouri border after July 1, 2008.
